PROVIDENCIA

It is one of the most beloved bouldering destinations in the country. There are also multi-pitch climbs, sport climbing, and worldclass tree climbing. Surrounded by primary forest and located next to the Quetzales National Park, it is a place of great biodiversity, clean water, and a community that embraces environmental care, mountain sports, conscious ecotourism, and values of a living a good life. We invite you to a personal and collective exploration through climbing and training, where we will review our map of relational bonds to reimagine our lives.

This is a climbing retreat (on rock and in trees) to experience and learn from modalities and ways of moving with these sacred beings. We will challenge ourselves to grow, strengthen, and align our bodies, guided by the wisdom of our inner nature.

INTENTION

The intention of this retreat is to re-connect with the wisdom of our bodies to awaken the possibility of listening to the world and life. Relational art invites us to review our connections and bring to consciousness the ways in which we are experiencing them, how we nurture them, what practices we have, and how we heal them. We firmly believe that climbing is a personal and collective practice involving strenuous physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual work.

Those of us who climb know that each person embodies their own style, their own 'beta.' We want to bring together various individuals embodying these practices and examine how their relationships unfold.





RELATIONAL ART AND LEADERSHIP

Relational art is an invitation for our family, social, work, climbing, and nature connections to be a practice of creation, imagination, and will. The review of our relationships and practices is a way to bring awareness to ourselves and the world we inhabit. The leadership demanded by this time requires firmness and awareness of the body and our relationship with the earth. The best way to achieve this is through the clarity of our relationships. We will reimagine leadership and cultivate a <u>leadership of friendship</u>, as our friend Shilpa Jain mentions.





WHIO IS THIS RETRET FOR?

This retreat is for climbers of all levels who seek a nurturing environment that inspires us to be true to ourselves and flourish. It's a brave space to learn from our relational bonds. We invite people of all genders because we believe that those who have questioned their gender identity and ways of relating, beyond the heteronormative framework, have taken steps towards awareness of their connections.
